2023 National Workforce Benchmarking Survey of Social Workers and Wider Social Care Workforce Employed Within Employed Within VCSE Sector Supporting People With Mental Health Conditions Across England

The NHS Benchmarking Network and NHS England are pleased to announce that the 2023 National Workforce Benchmarking Survey of the Social Workers and Social Care workforce within mental health services across England is now open for data submissions. The collection will build on previous work delivered in 2020 and 2022 by the NHS Benchmarking Network that profiled social workers working in mental health services. This collection will help establish a comprehensive profile of the social worker and the wider social care workforce including data from the NHS, local authorities, the independent and voluntary sector.

Using this evidence, we can inform education and workforce planning and investments for now and in the future as part of the Mental Health Implementation Plan to achieve the NHS Long Term Plan ambitions.
